

Meeting Room Hire

Jamyang Buddhist Centre Leeds is situated in the centre of Holbeck, on the corner of Ingram Road and Crosby Street. The Centre is used for all kinds of community activities such as mindfulness classes and community gatherings.

We currently have two spaces for hire, one large open plan hall and a smaller meeting room.

The hall can accommodate:

- 130 Theatre Style
- 60 In a circle
- 45 Café style

The meeting room can accommodate:

- 10 board room style
- 14 in a circle without the table

We have:

- 73 chairs (56 padded, 17 plastic)
- 8 tables seating 6 each
- 26 small coffee tables
- 40 mats & cushions plus some blankets (for yoga/meditation etc.)

The rooms have heating or air conditioning to suit your needs. The hall is bright, always kept clean and tidy, and has large windows on one side which have black-out blinds. The meeting room has glass doors into the corridor. There is Wi-Fi throughout the building, and the centre also has its own café and shop.

Terms and Conditions

1. See price list for charges of our various meeting rooms and equipment.
2. Cancellation Policy and Fees:
3 weeks prior to the event: No cancellation fee.
2 Weeks prior to the event: 50% of the relevant venue booking (room hire)
1 Week prior to event: 100% of the room hire.

3. Jamyang Buddhist Centre Leeds (JBCL) will send an invoice after the event - payment is required within 14 days of receipt of the invoice. 50% of the room hire is required in advance as a deposit.
4. JBCL cannot accept any liability for any damage to persons or property. Individuals who are running courses must have public liability and professional indemnity insurance. **JBCL is also not responsible for any of your own equipment you bring onto our premises – you must have your own insurance policy for such items.**
5. The booking charge covers the use of the Hall or Meeting Room, heating, lighting, and toilet facilities. Also included is wireless. Use of projector/flip chart (including paper and pens) is charged separately. A small charge is asked to cover tea/coffee and biscuits.
6. We would appreciate course leaders taking every care to avoid damage to the Hall or Meeting Room and any JBCL facilities and equipment. In the event of damage above normal wear and tear, a charge will be made.
7. Course leaders are requested to ensure that excessive or inappropriate noise is avoided, both in the Hall/Meeting Room and in the rest of the building. Laughter is welcome!
8. Smoking or drinking of alcohol is not permitted anywhere in the building.
9. There is free on-street parking facilities, but no off-street parking.
10. If you wish to include mention of JBCL in any advertising literature, we would appreciate gaining approval from us first.
11. Once we have confirmed availability, please fill in the online booking form and send it together with your payment in order to make a firm booking. Your signature on the booking form is considered acceptance of our terms and conditions.
12. No tenancy is created by acceptance of these terms.
13. There are no cooking facilities. You may bring food of your own (vegetarian only please) into the cafe area, but not into the meeting room itself.
